## A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF TWO ROADS

**WHEREAS,** in accordance with Sections 8 (1)g and 13 of The Cities Act the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and laneway be closed:

Firstly: "All of Crescent Street and portion of Eighth Ave. lying South of the Southerly limit of Darlington Street, Registered Plan No. P2307, City of Yorkton

Secondly: "All that portion of Balmoral Street lying East of the Easterly limit of Seventh Ave. N., Registered Plan No. 02Y01012."

More specifically as shown in the black shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

#### Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon consent of the Minister of Highways and on the day of final passing thereof.
