Bylaw No. 27/2011

A Bylaw in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the permanent closure of portions of Brodie Avenue, part of Agricultural Avenue and parts of lanes in Plan No.'s 7023 and 46116

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act,* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following portions of streets be closed:

"Firstly, all that portion of Agricultural Avenue described as follows: Commencing at a point 3.50 meters Easterly of the production of the Southerly limit of Lots 1 to 5, Block B, Reg'd Plan No. 46116, thence Westerly to the South Easterly corner of the said Lot 5 Block B, thence Northerly along the Westerly limit of Agricultural Avenue to the Southerly limit of Broadway Street, thence Easterly along the Southerly limit 17.19 meters, thence Southerly parallel to the Westerly limit of Agricultural Avenue 13.50 meters, thence South Westerly to the point of commencement."

"Secondly, all that portion of the lane South of Lot 27, Block B, West of the production, Southerly of the Easterly limit of Lots 27 to 42, Block B, all on Reg'd Plan No. 46116."

"Thirdly, all of Brodie Avenue from the Southerly limit of Broadway Street to the Northerly limit of Borden Street as shown on Reg'd Plan No. 46116."

"Fourthly, all of the Lane North of Lot 22, Block A, Reg'd Plan No. 46116."

"Fifthly, all that portion of the lane north of Lot 42, Block B, West of the production, Northerly of the Easterly limit of Lots 27 to 42, Block B, all on Reg'd Plan No. 46116."
