1. That Official Community Plan Bylaw No. 12/2014 is amended to change the Land Use Concept for Lots 25-27, Block 1, Plan 99Y00657, civically known as 20 and 24 Gladstone Avenue South, as shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto, from Residential to Commercial.
