BYLAW NO. 2/95

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE AND DEREGISTRATION OF PUBLIC RESERVE LAND

The Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan hereby enacts as follows:

1. Pursuant to Section 200(2), of <u>The Planning and Development Act</u>, 1983, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to request and execute such documents as may be necessary by the Minister of Municipal Government to sell a portion of the Public Reserves for the Queen Street widening project and to deregister Public Reserve Lands for the future development of a cemetery.

Firstly:

Public Reserve R3, R4 & R5, all in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, according to a Plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the Yorkton Land Registration District No. 82-Y-04242.

EXCEPTING THEREOUT AND THEREFROM:

<u>Firstly</u>: All Mines and Minerals out of said Public Reserve R3 as reserved by virtue of a Plan registered as No. 79-Y-09101.

<u>Secondly</u>: All Mines and Minerals out of said Public Reserve R4 as reserved by Transfer registered as No. 81-Y-09408.

<u>Thirdly</u>: All Mines and Minerals out of said Public Reserve R5 as reserved by virtue of a Plan registered as No. 82-Y-042242.

Secondly:

Buffer Strips Bl, B2, B3 and B4, and the Public Reserves R4 and R5, in the City of Yorkton, in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, according to a Plan of Record in the Land Titles office for the Yorkton Land Registration District as No. 77-Y-06057.

2. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Government.
