BYLAW NO. 1/2026

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN
TO AMEND BYLAW 46/2008 TO APPOINT THE YORKTON HOUSING
CORPORATION BOARD**

WHEREAS The City of Yorkton has an ongoing need for a range of affordable housing options for residents, including seniors, families, students, persons living with disabilities, and other households;

AND WHEREAS the housing units operated by Yorkton Housing Corporation currently accommodate eligible residents who are not exclusively seniors;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed prudent and in the public interest to amend Bylaw No. 46/2008 to reflect current operations and to support eligibility for housing programs and funding opportunities that are not restricted to seniors housing;

THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. THAT in the first clause that reads “WHEREAS it is deemed advisable to establish and appoint members to a Board of Council known as the Yorkton Housing Corporation to manage and oversee the operations of an all senior housing facilities owned by the City of Yorkton.” strike the word “seniors”;

2. AND THAT Section 2 of Bylaw 46/2008 be amended by striking “for the accommodation of low income seniors” to read “The Board shall maintain and operate self-contained housing units on a not for profit basis as efficiently as possible to best meet the needs of the residents of the City of Yorkton.”

3. **Effective Date of Bylaw**

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the day of final passing thereof.
