BYLAW NO. 7/2001

**A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF
SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF CERTAIN STREETS AND
LANES AS SUCH STREETS AND LANES ARE SHOWN ON A PLAN OF RECORD IN
THE LAND TITLES OFFICE AS PLAN NO. P2307 AND PLAN NO. 00Y05677**

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 156 of *The Urban Municipality Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and lanes be closed:

- “Firstly: (a) All that portion of Seventh Avenue, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan P2307 lying West of the West limit of Parcel F Plan AN6154, East of Block 8 and 9 and North of the North limit of Balmoral Street East shown on said Plan P2307.
(b) All that portion of Seventh Avenue, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan P2307 lying West of a line joining a point being the intersection of the South limit of Crescent Street and the East limit of Seventh Avenue with the North east corner of Lot 18, Block 20, Plan P2307 and East of the Easterly limit of Block F, Plan AN6154.
- Secondly: All that portion of the East – West lane, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan P2307 lying South and adjacent to Lot 47, Block 9 and East of a line joining the North East corner of Lot 6, Block 8 with the South West corner of said Lot 47, Block 9, on said Plan P2307.
- Thirdly: All that portion of the East West lanes, Yorkton, Saskatchewan, Plan 00Y05677 lying East of a line being the production Northerly and Southerly of the most Westerly limit of Lot 5, Block 7 on said Plan 00Y05677.”

More specifically as shown by the hatched areas on the map, identified as Schedule ‘A’ which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
