
A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the permanent closure of a portion of Highway 9 right-of-way, adjacent to 115 Palliser Way

WHEREAS, pursuant to Sections 8 (1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following street be permanently closed:

1. As shown on Schedule 'A' attached hereto, all that portion of ST/L 1, Plan 86Y11910 Ext.l more particularly described as follows: the most Easterly 6.1m in perpendicular width adjacent to Block D, Plan 97Y09031, bound on the North by the Westerly production of the North Boundary of said Block D; and bound on the south by the Northwesterly production of the Southerly Boundary of the said Block D.

All those named Streets, Lanes, Blocks, and Plans being in the City of Yorkton, Province of Saskatchewan, Dominion of Canada.

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
