BYLAW NO. 1913

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON TO CHANGE THE NAME OF CERTAIN STREETS.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton deems it advisable to change the name of certain streets so that they will more properly conform to land use. NOW THEREFORE the Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows: 1. THAT "St. John Street" be changed to "Smith Street" lying north of the railway Registered Plan No. BA4176, as shown on Registered Plans Numbers S700, V1324, 60YO2441, 61YO5743, 63YO4179, 66YO9992, and 68YO4966; 2. THAT "Smith Street" be changed to "Booth Street" for that portion lying south of the Railway Registered Plan No. BA4176, as shown on Registered Plans Numbers S700, V1324, AD3410, AW4410, BA4176, BC2310, BZ748, CE6891, CI1691A, 60YO2441, 62YO0144, and 64YO8801. 3. Bylaw No. 1912 of the City of Yorkton is hereby repealed. Introduced and read a first time this 30th day of September A. D. 1974. Read a second time this 30th day of September A.D. 1974. Read a third time, after unanimous agreement had been reached to have a third reading, this 30th day of September A. D. 1974, and then passed unanimously this 30th day of September A. D. 1974, and registered in the Bylaw Register of the City of Yorkton.
