A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE CLOSING OF A CERTAIN LANE AS SUCH LANE IS SHOWN ON A PLAN NO. 99Y07581

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 13 of *The Cities Act* of the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following lane be closed:

"FIRSTLY: "All that portion of the Lane shown on Plan 99YO7581, Block 12 lying to the North East of a straight line joining the North West corner of Lot 2, Block 12 to the South West corner of Lot 1, Block 12 and lying to the South West of a straight line joining the North East corner of lot 2, Block 12 to the South East corner of Lot 1, Block 12."

More specifically as shown by the hatched markings on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
