## A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF ONE LANEWAY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8 (1)g and 13 of The Cities Act the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and laneway be closed:

"All of the lane in Block 3, lying to the West of the Westerly limit of Seventh Avenue as shown on Plan 02Y01012, Yorkton Saskatchewan."

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A', which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

#### Effective Date of Bylaw

Consent to close this lane was given by the Minister of Highways on May 8, 2008. This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of final passing thereof.
