A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO AUTHORIZE THE SALE OF DEDICATED LANDS

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. That Pursuant to Section 201(2) of *The Planning and Development Act, 1983*, the Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized to request and execute such documents as may be necessary by the Minister of Municipal Government to sell a portion of the following dedicated lands at fair market value for the future development of residential lots along Dunlop Street:

Municipal Reserve MR1; in the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan, in the Dominion of Canada, according to a Plan of Record in the Land Titles Office for the Yorkton Land Registration District as No. 73-Y-02273.

More specifically as shown in bold outline, identified as Schedule A, attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw.

- 2. That the Clerk do such other things necessary to effect the intent of this bylaw.
- 3. This bylaw shall come into force on the date of final approval by the Minister of Municipal Government.
