City of Yorkton Saskatchewan

Bylaw No. 2/2021

A Bylaw of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan to provide for the appointment of Bylaw Enforcement Officers.

WHEREAS, Section 337 of *The Cities Act*, provides for the appointment of Bylaw Enforcement Officers:

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. The City of Yorkton hereby appoints the following as Bylaw Enforcement Officers for the City of Yorkton:
 - a. Designated members of the Canadian Corps of Commissionaires that are under a current agreement, and any amendments thereto, with the City of Yorkton to provide Bylaw Enforcement services.
 - b. Any person employed by the City of Yorkton in a Bylaw Enforcement Officer position or a Community Safety Officer position for the duration of their employment.
 - c. Any person under contract with the City of Yorkton to provide Bylaw Enforcement services for the duration of the contract.
- 2. These appointments shall continue at the pleasure of Council of the City of Yorkton.
- 3. The duties of the Bylaw Enforcement Officers shall be to enforce all municipal bylaws enacted by the Council of the City of Yorkton and other duties as assigned.
- 4. Repealing Bylaw

Bylaw No. 6/2003 is hereby repealed.

5. Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof.
