BYLAW NO. 1/2008

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF TWO ROADS AND ONE LANEWAY

WHEREAS, in accordance with Sections 8(1)(g) and 13 of *The Cities Act* the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following streets and laneway be closed:

Firstly: "All of Ontario Ave from Dunlop Street W. to Henderson Street W. as shown on Registered Plan No. Z1894."

Secondly: "That portion of Henderson Street W. between Gladstone Avenue. N. and the eastern boundary extended southerly of Registered Plan No. 70Y08092, as shown on Registered Plan Z1894."

Thirdly: "All of the laneway bordered on the west by Part of Block 9, Lots 1 through 18 on Registered Plan No. Z1894, and on the east by Part of Block 9, Lots 33 through 50 on Registered Plan No. Z1894."

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A', which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.

Effective Date of Bylaw

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon consent by the Minister of Highways and on the day of final passage thereof.
