A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE AND TRANSFER OF A LANE WITHIN BLOCK 3, PLAN 36064.

WHEREAS in accordance with Sections 8(1)(g) and 13(1)(b) of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton in the Province of Saskatchewan in Council assembled hereby enacts that the following lane be closed:

All that portion of the lane lying north of Lot 11, Block 3 in Registered Plan No. 36064.

More specifically as shown in the shaded area on the map, identified as Schedule 'A' which is attached to and forms part of this bylaw.
