BYLAW NO. 17/2003

A BYLAW OF THE CITY OF YORKTON IN THE PROVINCE OF SASKATCHEWAN AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO DISPENSE WITH THE MAILING OF ASSESSMENT NOTICES

That Council of the City of Yorkton in Council assembled enacts as follows:

- 1. That pursuant to Section 184 (20) of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton hereby authorizes the Assessor to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices, if the assessed value of a property:
 - a) has not changed from the previous year's assessed value: or
 - b) the increase or decrease in assessed value does not exceed the lesser of:
 - i) \$1,000 from the previous year's assessed value; and
 - ii) 1% of the previous years assessed value.
- 2. That in accordance with Section 187(1) of *The Cities Act*, the Council of the City of Yorkton hereby directs the Assessor, to publish an annual notice in one issue of a newspaper.

3. REPEALING BYLAW

Bylaw No. 9/98 passed on the 9th day of February A.D. 1998, authorizing the City to dispense with the mailing of assessment notices, is hereby repealed.

4. **EFFECTIVE DATE OF BYLAW**

This bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of final passing thereof and from year to year thereafter.
