Council Committee Appointments for 2017

Some 60 business and community representatives were appointed to Yorkton's 15 Council Committees and Commissions at the January 9, 2017 regular Council meeting. Appointments are made each calendar year on recommendations made by the Mayor.

Committees act in an advisory capacity to Council and individual Council members are also appointed to sit on each committee.

The various committees and commissions of Council include: Community Development, Parks and Recreation; the Development Appeals Board; the District Planning Commission; the Economic Development Committee; the Emergency Measures Organization; the Environmental Committee; the Gallagher Centre Board; the Municipal Heritage Advisory Sub-Committee; the Planning and Infrastructure Commission; the Property Standards Appeal Board; the Protective Services Committee; the Yorkton Business Improvement District; the Yorkton Housing Corporation Board; the Yorkton Airport Authority; and the Yorkton Public Library Board.

The Mayor is an ex-officio voting member of all Council Committees. All members of Council may attend any committee meetings and participate in proceedings but do not have a vote unless appointed as a member. Some committees, like the Emergency Measures Organization and the Yorkton Housing Corporation Board are composed entirely of Council members.
