

Snow Clearing Update for March 9, 2018

All 146 Kilometres of City streets have now been plowed. Staff have been working double shifts, plus four outside contractors were hired to assist in snow clearing this week. We are proud of the work that has been done in such a short time given the inordinate amount of snowfall. Note that a number of cities across the Prairies do not plow residential streets unless in extreme situations, but in Yorkton we plow after each significant snowfall.
