Emergency Update 1- 7:30 PM

Pumping is continuing throughout the city to alleviate ongoing flooding problems. New large capacity pumps have been installed at 4 locations bypassing the sanitary system to improve flows to move water. Pumping will continue throughout the night.

The underpass on Darlington will remain closed until further notice.

The city asks residents to continue to redirect water from sump pumps outside your homes as far away as possible from your homes and into your back alleys or to the street if possible. This will alleviate stress on the sanitary sewer system.

For anyone requiring emergency accommodation a reception centre has been arranged at the Howard Johnson Hotel on Broadway and Dracup Avenue. Dumpsters will be set up in key locations for any flood damaged material. Dumpster locations will be announced Monday morning.
