- Dutch Elm tree pruning ban is lifted from September 1 to March 31.
- Elm branches can be disposed of at the City of Yorkton landfill. Please identify to the staff that you are disposing of elm.
- The ban helps to prevent Dutch Elm Disease (DED). Thanks to our Urban Forestry Program and resident's support, this destructive disease has been kept out of Yorkton so far.

The Gallagher Centre Water Park will be closed for maintenance from September 4th - 29th

Why does the Water Park have to be closed for so long?

All the water must be emptied from the pools to complete the planned work. Once work is complete, it takes several days to refill the pools and rebalance the water chemistry.

Why not do the work throughout the year?

Regular maintenance work is done in the Water Park year round but major maintenance work can only be done when the facility is empty for a period of time.

What kind of work is being done to the Water Park?

Some of the work includes tile and grout replacement, improving ventilation, deep cleaning, replacing security doors and refurbishing the sauna.

We look forward to seeing you when we reopen on September 29th!

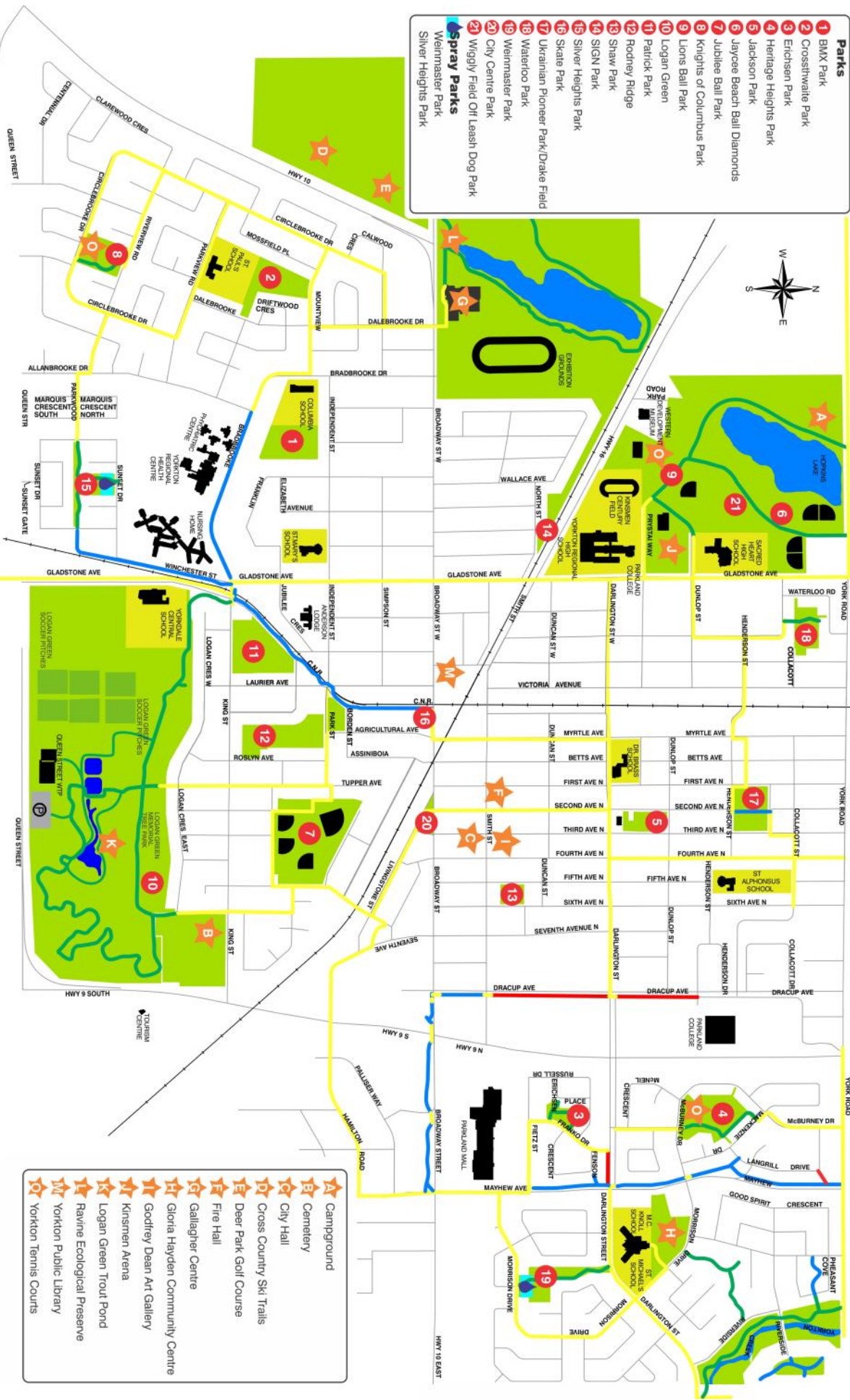


Did You Know?
