Yorkton Parks **TECH TIP**

Grass clippings can kill trees:

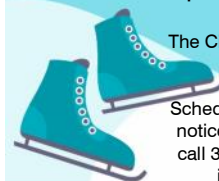
1. Excessive grass clippings piled around the base of trees can cause rot and decay of the tissues at the root collar, once decayed serious disease organisms can readily enter the tree.
2. When applied in thick layers, levels of oxygen available to the roots decrease as it will prevent air circulation.
3. When this thick layer of material starts to decompose the temperature rises disrupting soil temperature and potentially killing the roots.
4. Fresh grass clippings will form a dense mat which will reduce water infiltration to the root zone.
5. If grass were treated with herbicide or is exposed with spilled contaminants this chemical will be transferred to the root zone when clippings are piled in the base of trees.
