SPECIAL NOTES:

Building Services had canceled this demolition in 2018 due to the length of time it had taken SaskEnergy to remove the gas line.

The gas line has since been removed and we are requesting Quotations for a spring of 2019 demolition.

Details of Quotation:

- Demolish complete structure including the foundation
- Remove all concrete from the excavation
- Fill excavation with appropriate material to achieve compaction
- Compact excavation material to 97%
- Provide a Procter report for compaction
- Fence site through demolition and until excavation is filled
- Remove all demolition debris from the site
- Landfill fees shall be at the City's expense
- Work to be completed in Spring of 2019

Special attention to the retaining wall of the neighboring property must be considered in the removal of the foundation. All precautions are to be taken as not to damage this retaining wall.

If complications arise during the demolition then work will halt immediately and Building Services will be contacted for consultation.

The Contractor is required to have a Health & Safety Program and to provide a copy to the City. In the absence of their own Health & Safety Program, the Contractor must follow the City's Health & Safety Program applicable to the Department for which they are hired.

Contractor must provide the City with a Letter of Good Standing with WCB.

Contractor must provide a current City of Yorkton Business license on the awarding of the project
